“I feel the presence of the Lord!” We heard as we arrived in at my brother-in-law’s house unexpectedly one day. Adriano had recently come to the Lord along with his wife who had been backslid for nearly 6 years. The Lord spoke to him one day while he was walking through downtown working on his job as a street vendor that he needed to make things right between him and God. Magno and I had come to his sister’s house early to take a shower for service that night because our whole village was once again without water and electricity. As our nephew opened the door, we saw tears streaming down his face. His mother quickly came to see who had arrived also with tears running down her face. We feared the worst as doctors had recently found a lesion on Adriano’s brain after suffering several seizures. Instead, we found the whole family in prayer crying out to the Lord. Earlier, the presence of the Lord had passed through the house; the whole family felt Him make his presence known.

We baptized Adriano and his oldest son in Jesus’ name last Sunday night. Since their baptism and because of his testimony, his mother, stepfather, sister, and brother have come and repented of their sins. Each service God continues to move as new souls are coming to know Him. We are asking for your prayers for Adriano and his family. The doctors want to do brain surgery on him this month, yet they need to do another exam that will cost them nearly 1000 reals (around \$450). We believe that God is able to do the impossible.

We recently had a revival in Tabuleiro called “Faith as a Grain of Mustard Seed.” Another soul came to know the Lord during this revival and several were touched by the power of God. In November, the church in Araçás was inaugurated and Raul Jr. baptized 10 souls in the name of Jesus during the special services.

Since the year 2001, I have worked as a single lady under the ministry of Bishop Raul & Janice Alvear in Brazil. On December 3, 2005, Brother Magno Santos and I were united in marriage at a ceremony in our headquarters’ church in Maceió, Brazil. We ask for your prayers as we begin working together in the ministry to win souls in Brazil continuing under the same leadership of Brother & Sister Alvear. Before long, we will be traveling to the States to celebrate our wedding with our family and friends in Goshen, Indiana on January 14, 2006. We hope to be able to be with you at this time.
